24 JUL Wed. 5:00 p.m.	Nonprofit Boards - Governance & Policy (session #1 of 3) <i>The board's job is governance, the ongoing process of due diligence whereby the board operates as a collective to ensure corporate health and effectiveness of the organization and provide mission-based leadership. Governance is the process by which the board articulates organization values and mission, sets standards, controls, and policies, and assumes responsibility of legal and ethical matters.</i>
28 AUG Wed. 5:00 p.m.	Nonprofit Boards - Fiduciary Responsibilities (session #2 of 3) <i>A board ensures financial sustainability through adopting an annual budget, monitoring income and expenses, accepting audit reports, taking an active role in fund development, and overseeing the management of funds and property. Responsibilities include exercising prudence and sound fiscal practices within the organization, and faithfully reading and understanding the organization's financial statements.</i>
23 OCT Wed. 5:00 p.m.	Nonprofit Boards - Donor Development (session #3 of 3) <i>A board ensures that the organization is relevant to the community it serves through processes that monitor the external environment and define vision, direction, and strategy. Members assist with the development and implementation of development plans and fundraising strategies. Successful boards understand the importance of their leadership role in fund development. They realize that their role and involvement determines the level of fundraising success, and they embrace the opportunity to make an annual gift to the organization.</i>
